George shares his experience with others through seminars and presentations to students and practitioners. The most recent of these was a seminar to a class at MIT on facility programming and a presentation at the 2002 annual meeting of the Society for College and University Planning on the topic, "The US News & World Report's Rankings and Institutional Space Resources."

A selection of recent projects George has contributed to include: campus planning for Lesley University and Cyprus International University; space utilization studies for Cornell University; existing space analysis and space needs projection for the Connecticut State University system, the Ohio State University, and the University of Hong Kong; and facility programming for the sciences at Marist College and for the new campus of the American University in Cairo, Egypt.
